Things we have done to help your puppy get a good start:

- 1. Handled them often by inspecting their ears, paws, mouths; so as to make future health care easier
- 2. Introduced different sounds and items; so as to reduce the fear of new things
- 3. Added cinnamon to the potty area; so as to give you a method to show the puppy where you would like them to go potty during continued training
- 4. Only pet after they sit; so as to teach manding
- 5. Introduced the first steps of crate training
 - a. When placed in the crate, we gave a treat, played classical music, and covered the crate with a blanket. This helps them relax and enjoy crate time. Always take your puppy potty before and after crate time.
